FROM TRURO

Going towards Falmouth on the main road (A39) from Truro, after about three miles you come to the northern end of the Carnon Downs dual-carriageway by-pass. At the roundabout, turn off right - signposted Carnon Downs.

FROM FALMOUTH

At the north end of the Carnon Downs bypass, turn left - signposted Carnon Downs.

After a couple of hundred yards there are two turnings to the right at different angles: one signposted Wheal Jane (etc) and the next marked "Bissoe 2 miles". Take this second road. Follow for about half a mile - out beyond the houses into countryside. The road eventually starts to bend and drop: after a gentle 'S' bend there is a turning on the left, with an "Oak Farm" sign on a tree.

Please park as signposted.

THREE SPIRES SINGERS

The choir was formed in 1981 and usually presents four major concerts each year, mostly in Truro. They have performed virtually all the major choral repertoire with a number of major orchestras as well as their own Three Spires Orchestra. Soloists have come from all over the UK to sing with them.

Their Musical Director is Christopher Gray, who is also Director of Music at Truro Cathedral.

New members are always welcome: rehearsals take place on Monday evenings at Archbishop Benson School, Truro, from 7.30-9.30pm. Membership requires an audition, but those interested are welcome to come along to rehearsals for a few weeks as a trial period.
